She was very interested in it and it was encouraging. Each week she looked forward to what we would be studying next. However, the final lesson in this study hit hard on the gospel. She was obviously touched by the message and extremely uncomfortable. Since that, instead of moving forward, she has pushed back. She no longer wants to discuss the Bible and has even pulled back from us friend-wise as well it seems. I mark this up 100% to conviction of the Holy Spirit. Pray with me that God will continue to work in Sophie's heart and draw her to Himself. Pray that she will become open again to hearing the gospel and having conversations about the Lord. Ultimately, pray for Sophie's salvation.

There's also a young man named Alexandre who is seeking the Lord. He got my info from some one and approached me earlier this year wanting to know if I would study the Bible with him (a missionary's dream). He is not a believer, but seems to be very interested in becoming one. He's full of questions. We have been meeting consistently for a few months now. The study we do has two modules. At the end of the first module, I asked a question: "Who do you think Jesus is?" His answer was, "Pour moi, je dirais que Jésus, c'est l'amour." Which means, "As for me, I would say that Jesus is love." Pray for Alexandre!!! Pray for him to come to faith in Christ soon!!!
