Dear Church,

God continues to produce harvest in Talibon. You will see from the enclosed report that Pastor Josol reported four professions of faith for August. These are professions as a result of personal one-on-one evangelism in addition to the public preaching of the Word.

Our current project is the repair of our classroom huts and an expansion of our chapel. Our classroom huts have been visited by termites, and so we are not only repairing the damage, but also treating the huts to try and prevent future damage. The chapel extension is a framework over which a canopy can be stretched. While not crowded, the chapel is more full than empty on a normal Sunday morning. This extension will help to more comfortably accommodate crowds for special services, weddings, etc. In time, we will likely put a permanent roof on this extension, but for cost purposes we elected to forego the permanent roof at this time. The framework is being built in such a way that a permanent roof can be added to this original framework at any time.

The total cost of this project is just under \$1,200, but we did not ask for funds because—praise be to God and thanks be to you—it was there in our general fund. It is *such* a blessing to have Bohol Missions operating from a place of financial strength. Again, we give all honor and glory to God, but thank you for being one of the vessels He's using.

While we are still in favor of adding a second missionary to the work of Bohol Missions, we are no longer actively seeking one, per se. We have put out word to pastors and missionaries on Bohol, Leyte, and Luzon that we are interested in putting a new missionary on a new field, and so our desire is known. We had said we would add a second missionary at this time *only* if we were assured God had sent us the man He wanted us to send to a new field. Since that did not happen, we will be continuing to focus resources into the chapel and infrastructure of our property in Talibon so that when the time comes for the mission there to organize, they will not be straddled with an inadequate building, poor infrastructure, or debt.

As always, we thank you for your support of Bohol Missions. Your confidence in our handling of this field and your willingness to bless God's work is truly appreciated.
