Dear Supporter,

God continues to bless our efforts on Bohol, and for that we give Him all the praise.

The *best* news is always a profession of faith, and we are thankful that we saw one such profession in April. Praise God! Before becoming our missionary Pastor Josol was already actively engaged in one-on-one evangelism and preaching in the Talibon jail, schools, and police station. We have encouraged and continue to support and endorse all those efforts.

The most visible blessing of the month is that we now have plumbed water functioning on our property. Last month I reported to you that the well had been dug. During April, the pump, holding tank, necessary supply lines, and requisite wiring were all installed. We now have running water in both comfort rooms (bathrooms). We also have water plumbed to the future kitchen area. We have no kitchen on the property, but it is platted and we told Pastor Josol while we had the funds, the workers, and the ground torn up in various places anyway to go ahead and get a supply line to where the kitchen would be. More than once I heard the comment, "Wow," as people in Talibon observed the new water system in action.

We are thankful that getting running water to our property did not even cause a dent in our finances. We had not worried about financing the project because we had the funds in reserve, but it was a blessing to have the project completed and discover we still had as much reserve going out as we had had going in. Amen!

We loaned Pastor Josol out for a few days during April to help in the installation of a roof for Malbago Missionary Baptist Mission on the island of Leyte. This is a sister mission sponsored by Malingan MBC. Pastor Josol is good at working with his hands and willing to do such work. We have a good working relationship with Pastor Herbert Lumanta of Malingan MBC and were thrilled to be able to be a help to this mission work.

There is yet more good news. Pastor Josol and I have spoken back and forth for several months about the need of a scooter and/or jeep to aid in the ministry. Not everyone has transportation on Bohol and some areas are difficult to reach. Some of our mission members do not come when it's raining because they do not have a way to keep themselves dry on the way. Pastor Josol has a personal scooter which he uses...and which he also regularly has to work on to keep going, but

that is all we have had up until now. We have located a Jeep. It is a 26-passenger, and so has substantial hauling capacity for both people and—when needed—materials. Pastor Josol has inspected and test-driven it, and told me he thinks it would be a wise purchase. We have told him to proceed with purchasing this vehicle. It was listed at \$2300, but we authorized Pastor Josol to work out the details; he offered just over \$1900 and the seller accepted. The jeep is on Leyte and so we will have to spend probably another \$500 to get it shipped to Bohol.

In yet *more* good news, *we have the money on hand to buy this jeep*, which is why we have instructed Pastor Josol to proceed. I know some of you like to give toward these special projects even when we have money on hand, and so if you want to give toward the purchase of this Jeep we will credit your offering likewise and continue to hold our reserve for future additions to the mission property, adding a second missionary when God opens that door, etc.

As always, we so very much appreciate the confidence you continue to place in us to bless our mission with your giving. We're thrilled to be the sponsoring church for Upon This Rock Missionary Baptist Mission, the mission seems thrilled with our leadership concerning their ministry, and you supporters seem satisfied that your missions giving is being used wisely for mission work. To God be the glory, to you supporters be the thanks, and to God be the praise.
