God was once again good in Talibon, Bohol, Philippines.

We are thankful Pastor Josol's oldest son continues to improve from this brain surgery. He is back to doing schoolwork and fulfilling his positions in the church, and so far appears to be making a 100% recovery on or ahead of schedule. As they say on Bohol, dayega ang GINOO (praise the LORD).

We are also thankful that we saw three more professions of faith during June. While I don't mention it, every month Pastor Josol is not only conducting services in the mission, but also preaching to the Talibon Police Force, in the city jail, and in area schools. In addition, he does one on one evangelism and follow-ups. In our view, we could not have wished for a more focused missionary.

You will notice from Pastor Josol's report that he reported increased attendance numbers this month. I have not verified this with him, but I suspect part of the reason for that is the availability of the jeep. Many do not have transportation in Talibon and still others do not have rainproof transportation, and those obstacles do affect attendance.

We were recently approached by a man about potentially becoming our second missionary. During the questioning and discussion back and forth, we liked his answers and he liked ours. However, in the end he decided it would be beneficial for him to do some key things in preparation for going to the mission field before launching into the work. I encouraged him to do these things, and relayed to him that they were things I had also done as I was in the process of becoming a missionary. I say all this only to demonstrate this point: we are open to God using us in a greater way in the Philippines and are actively pursuing the possibilities of sending a second missionary.

As always, we *so very much* appreciate your support of Bohol Missions.
