It has served us well already with a few trips and was a much needed addition. We also added a Shower Trailer to our list of equipment to help people in their time of need. The trailer was purchased by a donation from Skyline Baptist Church in Madison AL. It is in need of some renovation's before it will be able to be put in service and we hope to have it ready within a few months.
