Dear Supporter,

It is a blessing to be able to again bring you a good report concerning Bohol Missions.

You will see on Pastor Josol's report that he reported two professions of faith for the month. Praise God! You will also see that attendance is higher than it has been in past months, particularly for the midweek prayer service. Pastor Josol has confirmed to me this is largely due to attendees being able to have transportation via the jeep that we recently bought.

On a personal level, Pastor Josol's son has continued his good recovery from his motorcycle accident and brain surgery. During July, he celebrated his 20th birthday.

In some discouraging news, we received word that we will be losing \$200 a month in regular support due to one of our supporting churches disbanding. It is discouraging to lose the \$200 per month, but it is also discouraging to know a church has disbanded. The loss of that regular support puts us at just over or just under in regular monthly support—depending on the finances of two churches that give based on percentages—what we need to cover Pastor Josol's salary. As we go forward looking to add a second missionary—which we do see as a very real possibility—and also wanting to get a fully functioning building at Talibon so our mission is not straddled with debt once they are organized into a church, we are now realizing finances may have to factor into that more. This month, our income did not quite match our outflows.

We are NOT in financial difficulty. You can see from the treasurer's report that we still have several thousand dollars available for use, and so we can weather lean months without stress. Obviously, however, we are having to look at future ministry based on what our income is and not what it was or what we hope it might be.

Pastor Josol continues to faithfully work the field in the community, police force, and Talibon jail. In July, the mission also hosted a Pastors, Workers, and Wives Fellowship that appeared to go well.

As always, we are so very grateful for your support of Bohol Missions. Because of you, a mission is doing well, other mission points are being considered, souls are being reached with

the gospel, and God's people are being disciplined. May God bless you for the way you have blessed His work is our prayer.
